Other Business

Rob Hyatt: Reported on EFDC which might involve the club and may need some involvement from club coaches.

Mick Higgins: Reported that the EVAC league had disintegrated as the main people had left. There was a proposed breakaway league involving 3 matches although there were other midweek leagues that the club could join. The meeting agreed to continue with the proposed breakaway league and re-visit the issue next year.

Peter Cassidy: England Athletics now provide for direct elections on to its council. Peter had asked the committee to approve votes for 2 specific members. This had been agreed and they had been elected.

Tony Maycraft: The club was setting the course for the Mayors Fun Run. Help was required with this and marshalling the course.

The club had a large number of trophies which had not been awarded for some time and which nobody seemed keen to win. The club should consider its trophies and perhaps award fewer trophies for specific events of season-long performances.

Doris DSB: Help with coaches will be required for the summer sessions.
